RECORDING of CHURCH

ATTENDANCE The CofE, in consultation with the DfE, etc. have issued advice that, until there are no restrictions on numbers attending, **churches will not be recording attendance** for school admissions purposes.

WALMSLEY CE SCHOOL ADMISSIONS IN SEPTEMBER 2021: An application for a place at a Bolton primary school needs to be made online via the Council's 'Citizen Portal' - www.bolton.gov.uk/admissions/primary-school-places). Closing date **15 Jan 2021**. Priority allocation at Walmsley CE School based on regular church attendance will also need a **Supplementary Information Form** (from school office) and then hand this to a churchwarden / church official *before the end of term*.
